STANDING ORDER - 5

Sub: Supreme Court of India – Filing of petition by convicts sentenced to imprisonment – Order XXI – Rule 6 of the Supreme Court Rules, 1966 – Surrender Certificate – Reg.


Copy of the letter received from Secretary General, Supreme Court of India is enclosed and has observed as follows,

"Whenever a convict is sentenced to a term of imprisonment and he prefers a petition before the Hon'ble Supreme Court, it is required to be stated in petition whether he has surrendered as per Order XXI Rule 6 of Supreme Court Rules, 1966. Proof of surrender by such petitioner is one of the pre-condition for posting such petition for hearing unless the Hon'ble Court, on a written application for the purpose, orders to the contrary.

Ascertaining the veracity of proof of surrender, at times, takes a long time. Now, therefore, it is requested that when a convict surrenders to undergo the term of imprisonment and informs the Court or to the jail authorities that he has filed a petition before the Hon'ble Supreme Court, the Court as well as the jail authorities concerned be directed to ensure that on the same day of surrendering, surrender certificate is forward to the Registrar(Judicial- I), Supreme Court of India, and a copy is immediately faxed to him".

Strict compliance with above directives shall be ensured by all Superintendent of Jail.
